

A different approach to technical education



Under privileged children acquiring technical education

Moti Nagar is a relatively noiseless area located in India's capital, New Delhi. We entered a state-of-the-art institute with several classrooms. There was only one student in each room. And what about the teacher? The number of teachers in each room was also one. At first, I thought the students were all locals, but after looking at them, all my doubts vanished as some of the students had come from Australia, some from Fiji or Saudi Arabia and others from far-off Ghana and Angola in Africa. There were separate trainings being conducted in each classroom. The classes continue from morning till night.

The training center is Koenig Solutions, one of India's leading technical educational institutes, which gained worldwide fame for providing technical training at a less price. Recently, Koenig invited journalists from all over the world to attend the training.

They welcomed us at Indira Gandhi International airport with a taxi waiting for us. But this facility is not only for the visitors but also for their students. From the airport, they dropped us at their own accommodation - Koenig Inn - situated in Karol Bagh, New Delhi, where we spent our night. In the morning breakfast was served, and we were provided pick-and-drop from and to the Moti Nagar training center. Everyday, it was the same routine - lunch and then back to Koenig Inn.

Students from different parts of the world come to Koenig for acquiring technical training. But what do they learn here? Certification courses such as Microsoft, Cisco, Oracle, Linux, Java, Red Hat, CISSP, Security+, CEH, PMP and many more. Hardware courses and certifications are also provided. Koenig is an authorized training partner for Microsoft, Cisco, Oracle, VMware, Red Hat, Adobe, Check Point, Novell, CompTIA, EC-Council, LPI and CWNP.

What is the reason behind Koenig's success? We wanted to know this from the Founder and CEO of Koenig Solutions, Mr. Rohit Aggarwal. He informed us that the most important feature is one-on-one training, i.e. one trainer for each student. The price is almost half of any other institute.

But at such a low cost, is it possible to provide quality training? Mr. Aggarwal said that there is an abundance of technical expertise in India. Generally, Indians have a good knowledge of Math and Science. More emphasis is laid on both these subjects since school days. This is the reason good trainers can be found here at a low cost.

With one teacher per trainee, the student can learn quickly and easily acquire expertise in the subject. For this, Koenig has three methods of training- Regular, Fast and Superfast track.
